Educational Corner: **Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month Facts**

1. **Asian American & Pacific Islander Heritage Month (AAPI) is May. The Symbol for the Month is Cherry Blossoms. Some use a Hibiscus flower as well.**



2. **The Cherry Blossoms for AAPI heritage month are important as they symbolize the ephemeral nature of life and are an attraction in numerous countries across Asia, including Japan which celebrates cherry blossom viewing.**
3. **AAPI Heritage Month is in celebration of those with origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, or the Indian subcontinent as well as Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander. Some of these origin places include, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand, Vietnam, Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands.**
4. **Asian American and Pacific Islander women served in World War II! Many women were trained as translators and interpreters. Other women put their lives on the line through the underground resistance in the Philippines.**
